

All work is life size except for some of the sculptures.


Lance Richlin's oil painting technique is an alla prima technique that requires the paint not to dry until completion.





He utilizes clove oil, which is a slow drying medium, to achieve expert accuracy and detail in his paintings. Lance has exhibited his work in many galleries and museums in Laguna Beach, California; San Diego, California; Corpus Christi, Texas; and Seattle, Washington including the following:

Author and Illustrator




Lance wrote an instructional article on creating expert figure drawings for the March 2008 issue of American Artist Magazine.
